## At a meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2020 of Little Somerford Parish Council

it was unanimously agreed that the following regulations should come into force

## REGULATIONS FOR GRAVESTONES AND MEMORIALS FOR LITTLE SOMERFORD CEMETERY & MEMORIAL GARDEN

A formal application should be made to Little Somerford Parish Council acting as the Burial Authority for the Parish of Little Somerford under the Cemeteries Order 1977 for permission to erect a headstone. A right to the grave is granted for a period of 75 years and is subject to the following regulations:

- 1. Headstones should be
  - a. no higher than 900mm (3ft) and no thicker than 100mm (4")
  - b. made from natural stone, granite or marble and may include an integral vase at the base
  - installed in full compliance with the current version of the NAMM Code of Practice (National Association of Master Masons and BS8415
- 2. No kerbing, gravel, chippings or any type of edging should be used to mark the boundary of the grave.
- 3. No sculptures or artificial flowers are permitted
- 4. No trees or shrubs should be planted, apart from by Little Somerford Parish Council

## **Location of Graves**

The actual siting of grave plots (including those reserved in advance) will be determined at the time of death. Graves will be allocated sequentially.

## **Garden of Remembrance**

The memorial tablets must be 12" x 12" x 2" deep – with an optional flower rose.

Urns should be made of biodegradable materials.

**NB** The upkeep of memorials is the responsibility of the family of the deceased in the first instance.
