Wiltshire Council state to report areas of litter problems on the My Wiltshire app. We would encourage residents to do this but our experience is that the case will be closed if there is not enough litter there. This suggests that our village will have to become like a "tip site" before Wiltshire Council will take any action. Who wants our village to get like this?
